# Say NO to Bloor Homes housing development of up to 200 homes on the land adjacent to the Mercure Hotel on the Whitchurch Road

#### What's happening?

On 26 August Bloor Homes submitted an outline planning application to CWAC for a proposed housing development of up to 200 houses on land adjacent to the Mercure Abbotts Well Hotel, on the Whitchurch Road, using the present entrance as the only entrance and exit for the whole development

## What to include in your formal submission to CWAC

When you submit, personalise it as much as possible so that objections are not lumped together, and share your own experiences of traffic issues, accidents, congestion and queuing that already exists.

## Here are some key points of objection you could also include:

- 1. The land is green belt not grey belt, and does not satisfy the special circumstances test for green belt
- 2. Eliminates the health and well-being benefits of a critical green space between Great Boughton and Chester
- 3. Prejudices the outcome of the local plan consultation for option A alone the none withdrawal of green belt is the right choice
- 4. The proposed access/exit for the site on and off the A41 will:
  - Increase queue lengths on a road that already sees queuing beyond Waverton several times a day
  - Further increase the unacceptable levels of air quality harmful to the health of all who travel and live close or on the A41
  - Increase the complexity of vehicle movements at the end of Toll Bar Road and along and across the A41, and inevitably increase the number of collisions and serious injuries that are already a regular feature of this length of road
  - Will further increase the risks to pedestrians and cyclists using the A41, making it even more hazardous and dangerous than it is now
  - Recent local housing needs survey showed 95% of households do not want large developments like this one
